## **STOP** and Notice & Note



When you're reading, the author often gives you clues that the character has come to an important understanding by having the character say something like, "suddenly I realized," or "in an instant I saw", or "it came to me in a flash", or "I now knew", or "I finally understood," ... you should STOP and ask yourself...

## How might this change things?

If the character figured out a problem, you probably just learned the **conflict**.

If the character understood a life lesson, you probably just learned the **theme**.
